COVID Protocols for Summer 2022

While we are still in a global pandemic, the world is slowly transitioning “back to normal.” At camp, we will not be mandating masks or social distancing. However, we will be living in community and COVID has proven to be contagious and have unknown lasting effects. Therefore, in the case of a camper or staff experiencing COVID symptoms, we ask that you put on a mask, inform Leadership Staff and the Health Officer, and, if so advised, take daily rapid tests while experiencing symptoms (we will have these on-site).

If a camper or staff tests positive for COVID, we will ask you to go home. Refunds will be given, or if possible, campers can register for a later week of camp.

If experiencing cold/flu symptoms:

1. Inform your counselor, and talk to the HO, who will determine if a test is necessary.
2. Put on a mask given to you by the Health Officer.
3. Caregivers of campers will be contacted by a Summer Program Director (SPD) to obtain permission to administer rapid tests. Caregivers may choose to pick up sick campers if they prefer not to have a rapid test administered.
4. Take a rapid test administered by the Health Officer:
 - a. if negative and symptoms are mild, continue on with your day wearing a mask indoors and observing physical distancing at all times, with permission from the HO
 - b. if negative but symptoms are severe, HO may decide to isolate you or send you home
 - c. if positive, you will need to return home until symptoms have resolved
 - d. Caregivers will be kept informed of results.
5. If remaining at camp, continue to wear a mask, and continue to check in with HO until symptoms have resolved.
6. If a camper tests positive and is sent home, we will inform the staff body and the families of that person’s cabin mates.
