



75th Anniversary Registration Instructions and Options

Meals Only-Not staying on site for the weekend but still want that tasty camp food? We want to make sure we have enough food for everyone so we are asking you to register and prepay for your meals. You can select individual meals or meals for the whole weekend. Add the people you are buying meals for on the people step of your registration by clicking add a child/parent. **For example**, if you are a family of 4 and you would like lunch and supper on the Saturday, you should add 3 more people to your registration and choose Saturday lunch and Saturday supper option for everyone. Cost for whole weekend of food for one person \$65, individual meals range from \$12.75 to \$15.50

Staying on site for the weekend-When registering you will have three sleeping options for people who would like to stay on site for the weekend to choose from. Those sleeping options also include food for the weekend for the number of people indicated. If you have more people in your group than the included meals in your sleeping option you will need to either add them to your registration or have them make an account of their own to register for meals. To add them click add a child/parent on the people step of registration. **For example**, if you choose a tent option that comes with meals for 1 person for the weekend and you will be a group of 4 you should add 3 more people to your registration and choose the meals only option for them.

Option 1: You can rent a whole cabin and fill it with your friends and family as you like. **Meals for 4 people for the whole weekend is included in the cost.**

Homewood is a Timber frame cabin that sleeps 10 plus people and has 3 bedrooms and 2 bathrooms. Each bedroom has a double bed and a bunk bed in it. The loft area has a futon. Cost \$650

Douglas Fir sleeps 7 people. It has 3 bunks and a single bed, as well as a separated living area and bathroom. Cost \$400

Cranberry and Raspberry both have 2 bedrooms and 2 bathrooms. One of the bedrooms has 4 bunk beds, and the other has a bunk bed and a double bed. Up to 12 people can sleep in each cabin. They are joined in the middle by large common space. Cost \$550

Oak Grove Cabins can each sleep up to 10 people and have 5 bunk beds, a bathroom, and a common area. Cost \$450

Option 2: Bring your tent and camp for the weekend!

Festival Camping- Cost is for one Tent and meals for 1 person for the whole weekend. Tents will mainly be located in the small rec field with access to washrooms nearby. \$80

Private Site-Camp in the forest like in the old days! Cost is for the site and meals for 2 people for the whole weekend. Walk or bike into your site, depending on road conditions cars will not be allowed on the other side of the dike. Most sites can accommodate at least 2 tents. \$170

Option 3

Hostel Style- Bunk and Meals-This option gives you a spot to sleep in a cabin or in the lodge and meals for the weekend. Choose a bottom or top bunk, if you don't have a preference please choose top. If you want to be in the same space as a friend or two you can add them to the cabin mate request. Cost \$100
