## **Who are Camps with Meaning?**

**CAMPS WITH MEANING** (CwM) is the Camping Ministry of Mennonite Church Manitoba (MCM). Camps with Meaning serves the MCM congregations and the larger community through facilities and programming (Camp Assiniboia and Camp Koinonia).

In our summer programming we reach out to kids and youth, as well as adults with mental and physical disabilities, from across Manitoba: inner-city to rural. We invite campers to a fun-filled week of new experiences, relationship-building and chances to both learn about Jesus' life and experience it. At Camps with Meaning, **we are connecting campers to the Creator, to community, and to creation.**

### **Summer Program Goals**

We ask all our summer staff to help create an atmosphere conducive to:

...discovering and nurturing of a meaningful relationship with Jesus and the Spirit of God,  
...affirming the worth of self and others, as well as developing skills in community living.  
...developing an appreciation for the Creation, learning responsible stewardship of it and responding in worship to the God who created it.

If you are completing your check outside of Winnipeg and require a letter indicating you are volunteering your time, please call the Camps office.

**Your CAR and CR checks are good for 3 years if you work consecutive summers.**

## Available Support Staff Positions

### **Health Officer:**

- fully certified in one of the following: MD, RN, LPN, EMR, EMT, First Aid Trainer
- provides medical services as needed
- responsible for distribution of medications to campers as needed

### **Camp Pastor:**

- provides daily devotionals to summer and support staff
- provides spiritual leadership and support to camp community

### **Kitchen Help:**

- assists Food Service Coordinator and Head Cook in preparation, serving and clean-up of meals

### **Maintenance Help:**

- assists Head of Maintenance with a variety of maintenance and upkeep tasks all around camp
